Please note: The Juilliard School requires that students entering the Bachelor's program have earned a high school diploma through the state's General Education Diploma (G.E.D.) or other state certified source. Your answers will provide guidance to our staff, especially as we evaluate the student's transcript. Please return this form along with the following: a full outline of curriculum by subject, including textbooks for each course; assessment procedure and grades; evidence of official recognition by the school district and/or state department of education.

3. Will the state recognize the student as a high school graduate?
